MHSA Budget Updates

- MHSA projections showed revenues increasing
- With MHSA Steering Committee support, the MHSA FY 2022-23 Annual Update includes:
 - 10% rate increase and 7% capacity increase for CSS and PEI direct service programs
 - Expansion of existing Full Service Partnership (FSP) programs
 - New Family FSP program
 - New Adult FSP program
 - Mental Health Urgent Care Clinic transition from INN to CSS funding

MHSA Budget Recommendation

For Steering Committee Consideration:

- Increased MHSA revenues create opportunity for one-time funding initiatives:
 - Dedicate \$11M of Community Services and Supports (CSS) funds to MHSA Housing Program to finance/develop additional dedicated apartments
 - Issue \$10M Round 2 of Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Time-Limited Community Building Grants
