First 30 days, services include: arrange for housing, provide transportation to DHA for benefits, Social Security, school enrollment, and Refugee Health Clinic for comprehensive health exams, provide English and cultural classes, employment services, and link with community resources as needed.

## INTENSIVE CASE MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS

6-12 month program works with refugees with complex issues (health, mental health, social integration) and helps them overcome barriers to integration and self-sufficiency.

Eligibility: refugee/SIV, asylees, etc. status, arrived to US within last 5 years, documented special and unique needs (Single-headed household, woman-at-risk, LGTB, young adults without permanent guardians, elderly lacking support system, etc.). *Note: Enrollment in the program may occur regardless of which agency assisted with resettlement process.*
