GMC Discussion

Key Themes: Complex, confusing, access issues, lack of standardization, performance concerns

Potential Solutions: Standardize processes used by providers, centralize and/or simplify, improve access to specialty services, analyze data and take action, increase and improve data sharing, state participation

Possible Strategies: Streamlining/unifying GMC, managed care models (*are the issues related to managed care or the model*) or reducing number of plans
