**Purpose:**

- A. To serve as a treatment standard for EMT's and Paramedics in treating pediatric patients with nausea and/or vomiting.

**Authority:**

- A. California Health and Safety Code, Division 2.5
- B. California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 9

**Protocol:**

BLS	ALS
Assess and Support ABC's as needed	Advanced Airway Adjuncts as needed
Supplemental O2 as necessary to maintain SpO2 > 94%. Use the lowest concentration and flow rate of O2 as possible	Check Blood Glucose
Assess and Treat as appropriate for underlying cause	Cardiac Monitoring.
Suction Airway as necessary	Consider IV NS 20 ml/kg if vital signs or exam suggest volume depletion. Recheck vitals
Transport patient in position of protecting airway	Consider <b>Ondansetron</b>  Patients ≥ 40kgs 4mg PO x 1; Max 4mg Patients ≤ 40Kg 0.1 mg/kg slow IVpush x 1; Max dose 4mg
