Welcome and Introductions	<p><b>Chairman’s report:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Update on Cares: David Magnino states that SCEMSA is currently waiting on the Hospital Council to give us their contact person for each of the hospitals. All CEOs have agreed to participate in the CARES program when it’s taking time to find who the person is for data entry on the hospital side.</li> </ul> <p>CARES is converting to a mandated state wide program vs. local program. The LEMSA Administrators are working it out on how to fund it and get a state wide coordinator because that is one of the state mandates. Tentative start date for our LEMSA is fiscal year 2017 for collecting data.</p>

Supplemental Old / New Business	<p><b>Medication Shortage/updates:</b> Nothing to report.</p> <p><b>Wall times:</b> No updates. David Magnino states he redistributed the letter Dr. Garzon wrote in regards to treatment while patient still on EMS gurney. David Magnino would like to form a workgroup to establish a definition/benchmarks for when wall times are extended. Providers should see the invite by month’s end.</p> <p>Discussion from providers regarding clarification of what kind of care is acceptable on an EMS gurney.</p> <p><b>New Business:</b> Introduction of EMD Policy preview. The policy is based on a survey SCEMSA sent out last year, asking providers what system they used for dispatching and from the results of that survey, SCEMSA drafted this EMD policy. David Magnino shows that the survey showed that all but one provider is using the same EMD system.</p> <p>Clarification asked regarding the EMD System B. in regards to ALS providers obtaining prior authorization from SCEMSA to modify an EMD protocol. Suggested edit from “modify” to “amend”.
