ALS personnel can contact UCDMC, MSJ, and KHS on all Trauma Triage patients refusing treatment and/or transportation.

** Patients requiring Interventional Cardiac Catheterization Services, as indicated by a 12-Lead ECG consistent with an acute myocardial infarction (computer interpretation reading ***** ACUTE MI ***** or *** ACUTE MI SUSPECTED *** or *** STEMI ***), or equivalent, who request a Kaiser facility should be directed to a Kaiser or Dignity Health Catheterization facility.
