Purpose:

- A. An Mobile Intensive Care Nurse (MICN) may be classified as inactive if that person does not meet the requirements for continuing MICN certification and whose certification has not yet expired.

Authority:

- A. California Health and Safety Code, Division 2.5
- B. California Code of Regulations, Title 22, Division 9
- C. Sacramento County Board of Supervisors, Resolution #2013-0478

Protocol:

- A. MICN certified in the County of Sacramento shall be classified inactive for any of the following
 - 1. Not employed by a current Sacramento County Base Hospital Emergency Department.
- B. To reactivate out of an inactive status, a nurse shall:
 - 1. Provide a current dated letter to Sacramento County Emergency Medical Services Agency (SCEMSA) of verification, from a manager or prehospital care coordinator within the last six (6) months of current employment at a Sacramento County Base Hospital Emergency Department.
