Please provide the following for COVID-19 hospitalizations and deaths to Sacramento County Public Health:

## Hospitalized COVID-19 Cases

- Completed confidential morbidity report (CMR) form:
- Patient demographics and sensitive occupation fields (if applicable)
- Reporting health care provider information
- Hospitalization status and diagnostic testing
- Clinical information
- Vaccination status in Additional Remarks

Note that hospitalized COVID-19 cases should include those who:

- Test positive for COVID-19 (via PCR, antigen, or sequencing)
- Have acute symptoms consistent with COVID-19 requiring hospitalization
- Admitted for at least 24 hours (not emergency department or outpatient visits only)


## COVID-19 Deaths

- Completed confidential morbidity report (CMR) form:
- Patient demographics and sensitive occupation fields (if applicable)
- Reporting health care provider information
- Hospitalization status and diagnostic testing
- Clinical information
- Vaccination status in Additional Remarks
- Medical records
- Admit note
- History and physical
- Progress notes
- Discharge note/death summary


## Reporting Test Results

Provide a copy of the lab report (PCR or antigen). Completing the COVID-19 Testing section of the CMR only is not sufficient.
