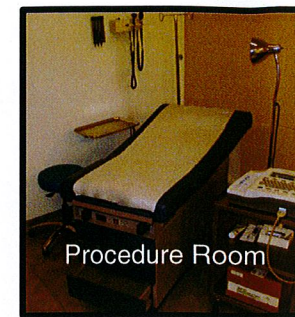
Access to healthcare treatment within the facility

We operate with medical staff on-site 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including weekends and holidays



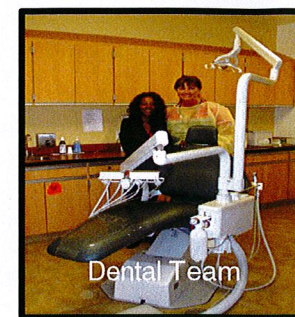
Nurses' Station

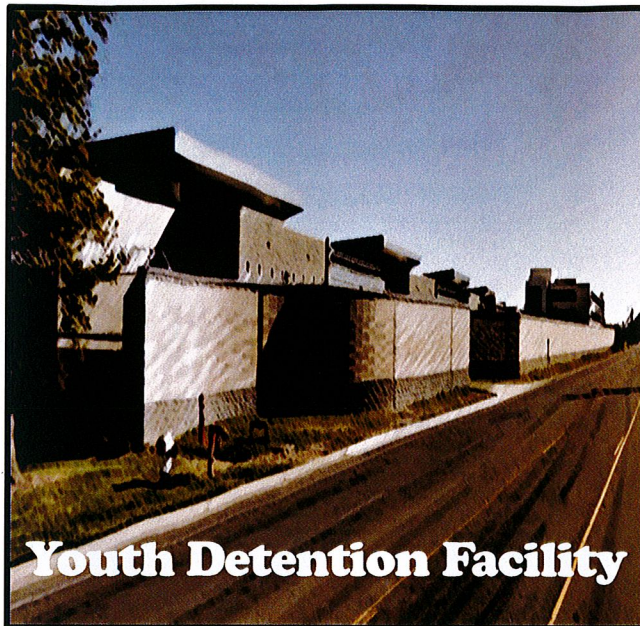

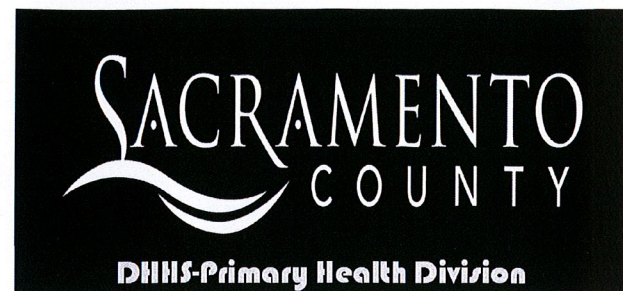
